

Clear-Cutting Forests

Date of Adoption: April 15, 2005

Date of Expiration: April 15, 2008

Preamble: Whereas cutting down large areas of forest disturbs the plant, animal growth and larger ecosystem the in an area, allowing disease to flourish; and

Whereas clear-cutting causes animals to be pushed into human controlled areas forcing them to become more dependant on humans for survival; and

Whereas paper made from hemp fiber is stronger and cheaper than paper produced form work; and

Whereas normally particle board can be made from pressed wheat, straw or hemp for an equivalent price to a wooden particle board; and

Whereas forests take years to normalize after being clear-cut.

Resolution: Therefore be it resolved that the Kwantlen Student Association oppose clear-cutting.
