Re: Counting of Ballots and Complaints

Background

As you will be aware, I sent a message yesterday to all candidates and to Ms. Giles and to Mr. Crane advising that I will be proceeding with the counting of votes today, October 20 at 8am but the counting will not be completed and no declaration will be made as to the successful candidates until all complaints have been investigated and I have had the opportunity to receive independent legal advise with respect to the complaints. This Notice supplements that message.

I have received a request from Mat Huff for an extension to enable him to respond to SVP Complaints number 9 and 10. I also note that I have not yet received any response from the SVP to Complaint number 2 made by Steve Lee. (The SVP Complaints numbers 9 and 10 and Complaint number 2 made by Steve Lee are referred to as the “Current Complaints”.)

By this Notice, I request all candidates and their legal advisors to notify me immediately if there are any other outstanding complaints.

Mat Huff has also requested that all candidates be given time to make further complaints in respect of alleged election violations occurring in the last few days of campaigning.

Paragraph 7(a) of the Order of the Honourable Mr. Justice Bauman of the British Columbia Supreme Court made on August 21, 2006 provides me with complete discretion and authority to conduct the General Election as I see fit in a fair and impartial manner and in manner consistent with the Bylaws. Paragraph 14 of that Order provides that the parties and the Chief Returning Officer shall be at liberty to apply to the Court with respect to any matter arising pursuant to the Order.

Rulings

Pursuant to my discretion and authority conferred by the Court Order, I make the following rulings:

1. I will commence the counting of the ballots today, October 20, 2006 at 8am as previously notified to the candidates;
2. The dead-line for responding to Current Complaints is extended to midnight tonight, October 20, 2006;
3. The dead-line for making any new complaints arising out of the General Election is midnight on Sunday, October 22, 2006;
4. The dead-line for responding to any new complaint is midnight on Tuesday, October 24, 2006;
5. The completion of the counting of the ballots and the posting of the results of the General Election shall be adjourned until Monday, October 30, 2006 or to such later date as I may notify the candidates in order to enable me to fully consider and decide upon the complaints, having received any required independent legal advice.

This adjournment will enable candidates to:

- (a) Respond to Current Complaints by midnight tonight;
- (b) Make any new complaints no later than midnight on Sunday, October 22, 2006;
- (c) Respond to any new complaints no later than midnight on Tuesday, October 24;
- (d) Obtain legal advice and, if desired, apply to the Court with respect to any matter arising out of the General Election as provided by paragraph 14 of the Court Order.

The adjournment will also enable the Interim Council of the KSA to consider my request for additional funding to assist me to obtain legal advice on the complaints.

The foregoing is subject to any Order that may be made by the Court.
