

October 18, 2006 SVP COMPLAINT #10

Complainant: Student Vision Party (SVP)

Alleged Offender(s): Mohammed Kallas and Concerned Students of Kwantlen Party (CSK)

Date: October 16, 2006

Time: Approximately 4pm

Location: Richmond Campus Rotunda

Mohammed Kallas was directly witnessed by Daljit Sandhu, Neil Lilly and Harjit Sandhu, illegally distributing the pay stub of current Richmond Director Brian Tran. Kallas was handing copies of it out to students as they passed by, using it directly and undoubtedly as campaign material.

Not only was this material not approved, it was never supposed to be used in this manner, and violates the principle of fairness in the election. It has already been forcibly removed by a previous CRO ruling, from appearing on the personal website of Steve Lee and the CSK: www.steveleenow.net or www.concernedstudents.ca

This is in direct violation of the following:

Section 10, article 5(4)(4) which clearly states that all campaign material must be approved by the CRO before it is used. **This is a direct and deliberate violation**

Section 10, article 6(11) which clearly states that: Slates, as a whole, are responsible for the electoral conduct of their members. If a candidate, who is also a members of a slate, is found to have committed an offence the Elections Committee may penalize any or all members of the slate in addition to the specific candidate who committed the offence. In Particular, if the entire slate has received a **material advantage** in the election from the actions of one or more members of the slate, the entire slate may be penalized. **This is a direct and deliberate violation**

The SVP argues that this has had a substantial **material effect** on the election, therefore, we recommend that **Mohammed Kallas be disqualified and some campaign privileges of the slate be withheld** because it has impacted the election, or whatever other decision that you may reach.
