

Complaint Against Student Vision Party

Violation: Using KSA resources to campaign in the election, Section X Article 5(5).

1. On both the Surrey and Richmond campuses several Student Vision Party (SVP) supporters were seen handing out campaign materials with red KSA shirts on. Wearing an official shirt of the KSA while handing out campaign material for a specific slate can be construed as the party having KSA support.

2. At least two students at the Surrey campus were given KSA shirts by SVP supporters/members as 'vote for me' gifts, and encouraged to wear them. I approached three men in the Chartwells cafeteria in the evening during campaigning, and they told me that this had occurred and showed me the t-shirts they were given.

3. Aaron Takhar was seen hanging around with various SVP members/supporters on the Surrey campus and talking to students while SVP members handed them campaign material. This occurred during regular KSA office hours.
