Chief Returning Officer's Interim Progress Report**

It is my pleasure to make this interim progress report to Council concerning the 2005 KSA General Election. I want to assure you that I consider the review of the election and preparation of my report my top priority at the moment. The following paragraphs outline my progress to date. My decision regarding Newton balloting is attached.

As you are aware, balloting took place on all four campuses on 24 and 25 February 2005. The ballots that were cast are secure, with the exception of Newton.

In the course of the campaign period and in the 72 hours following the balloting I received over 50 communications concerning the election. These have all been posted on line. I have also received over 20 pages of comments relating to the communications. These too have been posted on line.

I have summarized the communications and categorized the communications. I have been investigating complaints. I have been reviewing each communication, and the comments received about them, and have begun to apply the Bylaws, Regulations, and law to each of them. It is important that each communication be treated seriously and I will continue the process until the entire package is reviewed and decisions are reached on each one of them.

The review is going well. I expect that it will be completed next week and the decisions that I make will be posted as soon as it is completed.

The one decision that I am prepared to issue now concerns the Newton ballot box. My decision is attached to this report.
