Progress Report
12 April 2005

As I indicated in my report dated 9 April 2005, polling has been completed and the ballots counted. The results of the count are presented below in the “Results of Polling” section. Where there is an issue known to be outstanding at this time relating to a candidate, that issue is noted by her or his name.

At this time I am also releasing the total numbers of ballots cast at all four campuses. I have reviewed the voters’ lists and, to date, have not found any evidence that ineligible voters cast ballots. Some final checking remains to be done.

For your information, if the system was working perfectly, the total of “scratched off voters’ list” plus “not on list but eligible” should equal “signed voters’ list”. The “not on list but eligible” are the voters who prove to the poll clerks that they are eligible by providing a timetable or other evidence that they are enrolled or were enrolled last semester.

In this election, at all campuses but Richmond the “signed voters’ list” total was higher than “scratched off voters’ list”. Normally, I would expect that “signed voters’ list” would be the highest number. I have done some statistical checking of the Richmond “signed voters’ list” (and other lists) and not found any evidence to date that ineligible people voted.

For your information, I recorded the information needed to calculate the total number of spoiled / no choice ballots. I will release that information as soon as possible. Please note that there is, of course, no obligation for voters to actually cast ballots in any particular category, so a large number of spoiled / no choice ballots isn’t, in itself, unexpected.

To date, I have not had an opportunity to thoroughly review the election expense reports that I have received. This will be done by the end of this week and I expect that it will be included in my report to council on Friday.

Since, the ballot counting is complete and all relevant complaints that I have received to date have been disposed of, I believe that these results can be considered “unofficial results” pursuant to Regulation X 10 4 (xi). This specifically does not mean that other complaints are not possible. It is also very possible that Council may receive notification in writing that the Ombudsperson is considering an appeal pursuant to Regulation X 10 5 (iii).
