Whereas RAF supporters have already openly boasted to Progressive party supporters and member-candidates about the repeated destruction of Progressive materials without consequence from the CRO,




Whereas the action with the most material effect on the election being the habitual destruction of Progressive Media


The Progressive party requests the disqualification of the RAF Slate, in its entirety, from the Society's 2005 election.
