Harassment or threat of violence.

During the campaign period on January 19, 2006, a member of the Student movement, R. A. Scott, was approached by a member of the Reduce All Fees party (RAF) while campaigning at the Richmond campus. The RAF member demanded that R.A. Scott step outside and "Settle this." Mr. Scott refused and was then harassed by various RAF members for a length of time afterwards. I observed this as it occurred, and was disappointed in the way the RAF party members had conducted themselves.

Obviously, this sort of harassment cannot be allowed in a fair and civil election and is completely out of order. It has a direct material impact on the outcome of the election, as it inhibited Mr. Scott's ability to campaign effectively. It is due to this that the RAF party should be disqualified from the election.
