Nomination period: January 9-13

This package must be submitted no later than 4pm on January 13 to the KSA main office in Surrey. The package must be date and time stamped by Meenu Saran, at the Surrey front desk. It is the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that their nomination package is correctly stamped by the appropriate individual. The candidate shall be contacted over the proceeding 48 hours if there are any minor mistakes, however, if the Chief Returning officer (CRO) decides that the nomination package was not sufficiently filled out, the package shall be considered null in void.

All-Candidates Meeting: January 16

Every candidate must attend the meeting. If a candidate is unable to attend the meeting they must meet with the Chief Returning Officer at an alternate time. No candidate may begin campaigning unless they have met with the CRO. Further rules regarding this meeting can be found on the Society website. *It is advised that each candidate review the electoral section of the Kwantlen Student Association Regulations prior to handing in the nomination package.*

Campaign period: January 16-19

The official campaign period is the only time at which candidates may campaign after fulfilling the requirements of the above provisions. Campaigning is permitted only after the conclusion of the All-Candidates meeting until the end of close of polls

Voting Days: January 18-19

Polls will be open from 10am-4pm on both days. Ballots will be counted on January 20 and unofficial results released late evening on January 20.

The new KSA Board of Directors will assume office on January 23, pending election appeals to the ombudsperson.

REFERENDUM QUESTION 2006 GENERAL ELECTION

Whereas the current KSA fee structure is not easily translated into correct amounts to be remitted to the KSA and has therefore caused confusion; Whereas the current fee structure does not reflect the best interests of members of the KSA because of this confusion;

Whereas inflation has risen steadily over the past five (5) years;

Whereas the current fee has not been increased in the past five (5) years;

Whereas the current KSA Board of Directors has embarked on many new initiatives on behalf of the students of Kwantlen University;

Whereas the new fee structure is fair and balanced and would more accurately reflect the funds that the Student Association receives;

Whereas the lobby fund and daycare bursary funds as well as the capital fees will all be abolished;

Whereas continuous intake students will actually see a reduction in total fees due to the lack of KSA presence on the new Cloverdale campus;

The following fee structure is presented for approval:

Students will pay \$5.25 per credit

Continuous intake students will pay \$3.10 per week

The Lobby Fund, Bursary Fund and Capital Fee will be abolished
