There is also a referendum question on a separate ballot. The question can be found on the Society website homepage and is also attached for your reference. The referendum question was approved by the current KSA Board of Directors and is therefore being put forward to the electorate.

There has been discussion regarding a possible candidates debate to be held in the Surrey campus Café. We can deliberate on the issue and I shall make a ruling depending on candidates willingness to have a debate. Of course, not all positions will be able to be represented due to the large number of students participating in the election. This is something that will be discussed.

There is also discussion on the role of the current elections committee compared to years past. This is the first time an outside individual has been hired to conduct the Society's election. It is my duty to be fair and take whatever means necessary to ensure that this is the case. The committee shall function as my organization sees fit in accordance with KSA Regulations defining the role of an outside entity conducting its election. You must be aware that I am the official spokesperson for the committee and all communication must go through me. Committee members may not be contacted by candidates due to protocol that I use when conducting elections. I will elaborate further throughout the duration of the meeting as I realize that this is different for most incumbent candidates and those who participated in the 2005 KSA General Election.

If you have any questions and/or concerns before the start of the official campaign period please speak at the meeting or contact me personally. *Please ensure that you fill out the "Confirmation of nomination" form on the next page and hand it back to me before you begin campaigning. It solidifies that you have either attended the all candidates meeting or have met with me at another time to receive this package and are aware of all rules and regulations governing this election.*

By signing above I have agreed that I have fully read and understood all KSA Bylaws and Regulations and will abide by them and the decisions of the electoral administrators. I have attended the all candidates meeting of January 16, 2005 at 12pm in the Surrey Conference center in building G. I also fully understand the role of Amar Randhawa in respect to governing the election differently than if the Society were to conduct its own election as per Section 10, Article 4 (exigency provisions) of the Regulations which states:

*If the Board of Directors decides to contract out the entirety of an election to an outside entity, all provisions of the election section of the regulations shall be suspended and the election governed in a manner decided by the outside entity. The outside entity, however, must try to adhere to the electoral section of the regulations as much as possible.*

Having understood this provision, the role of the elections committee, among other things, may be different from that of the Society conducting internal elections. Anything different will be addressed at the all candidates meeting. It is my responsibility as Chief Returning Officer to conduct a fair and balanced election free of internal political turmoil. I will not engage in matters pertaining to past decisions of the Board of Directors, committees, or resolutions of general meetings. Please forward all concerns in writing to the appropriate individual. I will further elaborate on anything that will be conducted differently than what it is stated in the Society Regulations. Please ensure that you fully understand before you sign and begin campaigning! This meeting is the forum for discussion.

The referendum question appears on the next page. It has been available at all campuses and online (KSA website) since January 9, 2006. Please direct any concerns to the KSA Board of Directors. It is my duty to conduct the vote, therefore I cannot comment on the merits of the referendum. Please direct your concerns to the Board of Directors External representative.

Your society membership shall decide the new Board of Directors in the coming days!

## REFERENDUM QUESTION 2006 GENERAL ELECTION

Whereas the current KSA fee structure is not easily translated into correct amounts to be remitted to the KSA and has therefore caused confusion;

Whereas the current fee structure does not reflect the best interests of members of the KSA because of this confusion;

Whereas inflation has risen steadily over the past five (5) years;

Whereas the current fee has not been increased in the past five (5) years;

Whereas the current KSA Board of Directors has embarked on many new initiatives on behalf of the students of Kwantlen University;

Whereas the new fee structure is fair and balanced and would more accurately reflect the funds that the Student Association receives;

Whereas the lobby fund and daycare bursary funds as well as the capital fees will all be abolished;

Whereas continuous intake students will actually see a reduction in total fees due to the lack of KSA presence on the new Cloverdale campus;

The following fee structure is presented for approval:

*Students will pay \$5.25 per credit*

*Continuous intake students will pay \$3.10 per week*

*The Lobby Fund, Bursary Fund and Capital Fee will be abolished*
