Dear Mr. Browning,

This letter serves as an addendum to my previous complaints to the Ombudsperson regarding the Spring 2006 General Election.

Contentions

Proof of Contentions

In my second appeal to the Ombudsperson as submitted on January 29, 2006 I discussed this issue. In reviewing the video that I took of this, I found that the following people appear to have assumed office:

- Kulvir Gill, RAF Candidate for Richmond Campus Director
- Harm Sandhu, RAF Candidate for Richmond Member-At-Large (Listed on the door as “RCC Marketing Coordinator”)
- Brian Tran, RAF Candidate for Richmond Member-At-Large (Listed on the door as “RCC Financial Advisor”)
- Stefan Takhar, RAF Candidate for Richmond Member-At-Large (Listed on the door as “RCC Deputy Director”)
- Almo Ausbea, RAF Candidate for LGBT Liaison (Listed on the door as “RCC Head Liaison”)

It is curious that they have changed the names of the positions. It is even more curious that the LGBT Liaison would not list them as that liaison. Even if they had legitimately taken office, the failure to properly list what positions they hold may be a violation of the Bylaws and Regulations.

I very am concerned for the safety of Society assets and finances in this matter. Until the results of the election become official, following the resolution of all outstanding complaints – no one should be able to assume office.

Specifically, I would like the Ombudsperson to launch an investigation into this matter to find out if this has happened on the other campuses (Surrey, Newton and Langley) by contacting perhaps the KSA staff on those campuses. I would like this issue to be dealt with formally with a formal written opinion by the Ombudsperson on:

- the severity of this action;
- whether or not this action is legal;
- whether there is precedent for such action;
- a brief assessment of the legal liability the Society could be exposed to because of such actions (especially if these individuals are releasing funds from the budget and disposing of Society assets);
- a brief assessment of the remedies available to the KSA – can these individuals be held personally liable for any spending they may do or disposal of assets that they may do?;
- why these individuals took such action. On what grounds to they believe that they are allowed to do this?;
- how the KSA can implement changes to ensure that this does not happen again in the futue; *as well as*
- any other information related to this situation.
