**QUESTION**

**Do you agree** that the Kwantlen University College Student Association (KSA) shall adopt the following fee schedule (not including the fees for the Health and Dental Plan, the Canadian Federation of Students, and the Canadian Federation of Students - BC Component):

For credit courses (Academic students):

- Operating Fund: \$3.00 per credit, to a maximum of \$36.00 per semester
- Capital Fund: \$1.00 per credit, to a maximum of \$12.00 per semester
- Bursary Fund: \$1.00 per student per semester;
- Lobby Fund: \$2.00 per student per semester;

For continuous intake programs (trades students):

- Operating Fund: \$2.25 per week;
- Capital Fund: \$0.75 per week;
- Bursary Fund: \$0.06 per week;
- Lobby Fund: \$0.12 per week

**IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 4- REFERENDUMS OF THE KSA BY-LAWS, IN ORDER FOR A REFERENDUM TO PASS THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA MUST BE MET:**

- i. " A MAJORITY OR SUCH GREATER PERCENTAGE AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY LAW, OF THE VOTES CAST , SUPPORT THE REFERENDUM**
- ii. " THE NUMBER OF VOTES CAST IS EQUAL TO OR GREATER THAN TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY (250).**

**OFFICIAL RESULT:**

**ALTHOUGH A MAJORITY OF THE VOTES CAST WERE IN SUPPORT OF THE REFERENDUM, THE NUMBER OF VOTES CAST DID NOT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF ARTICLE 4 -ii AS PER ABOVE; ACCORDINGLY I MUST DECLARE THAT THE REFERENDUM WAS NOT SUCCESSFUL.**
