

**Notice for the November 29, 2005 Special General Meeting of the KSA was duly given by:**

- A. Obtaining approximately 350 signatures of students on all four campuses, stating the intent to hold a Special General Meeting on November 29, 2005, as submitted by Christine McLellan to the main office of the Society located on the Surrey Campus on the afternoon of November 14, 2005;
- B. Posting 25 posters (Attachment 1) on each campus giving notice to change the bylaws at a Special General, with the majority as posted by Noon on the morning of November 15, 2005 with the postings being tracked via a track sheet, which we never actually mailed back to ourselves as we noted we would do on the sheet (Attachment No. 2);
- C. E-mailing the Kwantlen Chronicle asking them to post notice of the meeting in their next issue, should it print before the November 29, 2005 meeting; *and*
- D. E-mailing the First Year Experience Website organizers to ask them to post notice of the meeting on the Kwantlen “what’s happening events” website.

Unfortunately, the Chronicle did not post the ad, but they did do an article on the Special General Meeting, which appeared in the November 28, 2005 issue of the paper (Attachment 3).

The Kwantlen University College First Year Experience website did however, post information on the meeting on their website (Attachment 4).

The majority of the posters hung remained hung over the two week period, as follows:

- A. As of November 28, 2005, 19 of the 25 posters hung in Newton remained hanging;
- B. As of November 28, 2005, we had not been able to make it to Langley to check how many posters remained hanging;
- C. As of November 28, 2005, 17 of the 25 posters hung in Richmond remained hanging; *and*
- D. As of November 28, 2005, 16 of the 25 posters hung in Surrey remained hanging.

Not every poster that people hang remains hung. We believe that the missing posters most likely disappeared through natural attrition – i.e. posters being moved / misplaced by other people who are posting posters. Considering the majority of the posters hung seem to remain hung, we do not believe or suspect that the missing posters are the result of any kind of sabotage.

Removing Jaivin Khatri as the Director of External Affairs; Aaron Takhar as the Director of Finance and Joey Atwal as the Director of Events and Student Life of the KSA; as well as removing their membership rights. The membership rights of Kulvir Gill will also be removed. They will be removed without prejudice for openly admitted to lying to the students to Council about the purpose for the September 29, 2005 General Meeting; for possibly giving prizes to friends at that meeting; for creating a toxic work environment that makes staff members and elected officials to feel uncomfortable and forcing them to even quit; for wrongfully dismissing, withholding pay, and otherwise harassing many staff and elected officials that spoke out against what they have been doing wrong; for failing to provide regular written reports to meetings of Council documenting the work they are supposed to be doing; for giving themselves pay increases and spending ksa money outside of the rules and procedures setup to govern the ksa budget; for hiring friends and family to positions within the ksa; for withholding the money passed to create bursaries for young student parents; for engaging in possible conflicts of interest regarding the purchase of pool tables, poker tables and who knows what else; for exposing the ksa to liability by having it be investigated for fraud by the RCMP (not that they engaged in fraud – they are innocent until proven guilty – but it still doesn't look very good).
